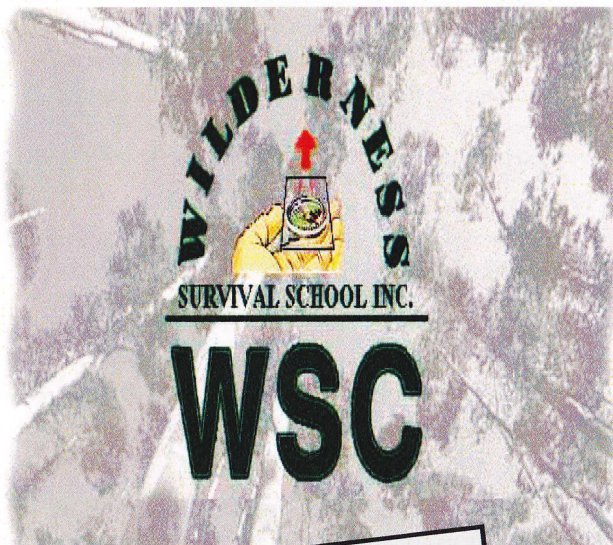
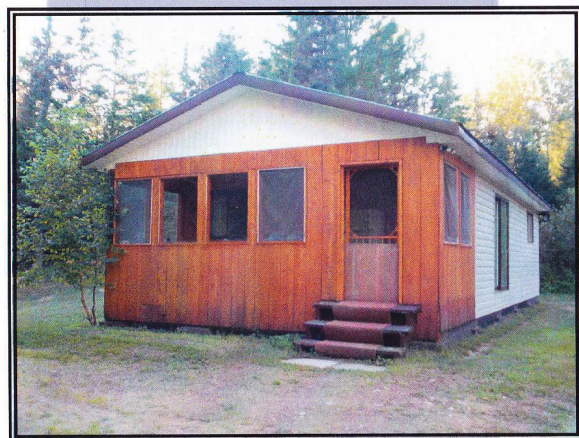


MISSION STATEMENT

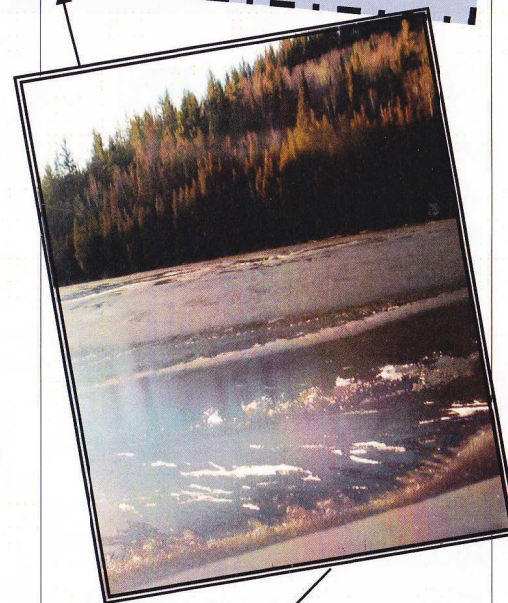

"WHO" SHOULD ATTEND Project LOST-YOUTH SURVIVAL?



INDIVIDUAL CLIENTS:

SPONSORED "FUNDED"

Paid by sponsors, fund-raising pool, intake partner.

PAID BY FAMILIES "PAY-PER PLAN"

Fees paid by parent(s), guardian(s), etc.....full fees apply unless application for reduced fees based on specific financial need.

INTAKE PARTNERS:

[a] SURVIVAL CAMPS 1-Week

Youth will learn how to survive and live the primitive lifestyle. Following a skills training component, the group will experience 6-days living off of the land at a remote wilderness site.

[b] WILDERNESS EXPERIENCE 1-Week

Participants will train in a variety of survival and outdoor skills, including backpacking, compass & GPS, canoeing, and survival skills. The group will backpack for 3 days to the interior backcountry, and spend 3 days making a survival camp.

[c] PIONEER HOMESTEADING & LOG-CABIN BUILDING PROGRAM 2-

Weeks

Clients live an "off the grid" pioneer lifestyle, complete with intensive chores, hard work, and survival skills training. Youth learn some basic log cabin-building skills, including various smaller building projects eg. shed, deck

[d] 1-YEAR INTENSIVE PROGRAM

Includes a field-aide mentoring program, 1-week survival camp, weekend skills trips, (canoeing, backpacking, GPS orienteering, winter camping, survival), monthly meetings/orientations, on-going evaluation, and periodic counseling sessions (anger management, self-esteem, goal-setting etc.), and career-counseling. Notes: all programs include skills training and certifications. Please visit our website for more detailed program outlines and details.

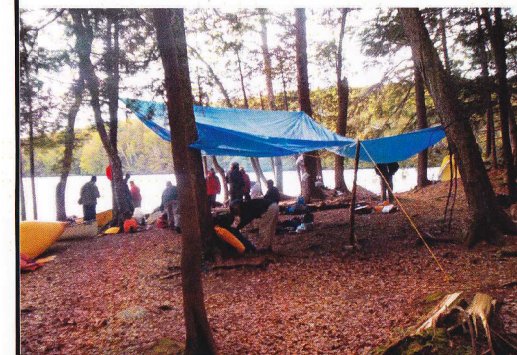
